Code of Conduct & Participant Agreement

The Nazarene Youth Missions Academy (NYMA) is a formational academy, not a recreational program. Participation requires maturity, discipline, accountability, and submission to authority. This Code of Conduct establishes expectations for all students participating in NYMA.

1. Foundational Expectations

All NYMA students are expected to conduct themselves in a manner consistent with Christian character, respect for others, and the mission of the Church of the Nazarene.

2. Authority & Compliance

Students agree to comply with instructions given by NYMA staff, instructors, mentors, house leaders, and designated volunteers. Resistance to authority, insubordination, or repeated non-compliance will result in corrective action.

3. Attendance & Participation

The following behaviors are strictly prohibited during NYMA participation:

- Possession or use of alcohol, illegal drugs, tobacco, vaping products, or misuse of prescription medication
- Violence, threats, harassment, bullying, or intimidation
- Sexual activity or sexually explicit behavior
- Theft, vandalism, or misuse of property
- Possession of weapons
- Use of profanity, hate speech, or demeaning language
- Unauthorized departure from assigned areas or activities

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5. Technology & Media Use
